HISTORY

Four years of exploits, adventures, anecdotes and achievement melt into just one more integral part of our past. But the unforgettable acquaintances and warm friendships which grew during this short time will serve to keep our memories vividly alive for many years to come. As a group, and as individuals, we can always be proud of our record here.

1957: We were finally in high school! Bewildered but excited, we joined into BHS life and tried to imitate the upperclassmen. Our first class officers were Woody French, John Deming, and Didi Bremer. Early in the year, we were kept busy learning and adapting to our new life, but it wasn't long before we took time out for fun. Didi Bremer and Dody Moses were elected to the Valentine Formal Court. Then the crowning freshman event — our party, gay with dancing, good food, games, and a talent show. As the year ended, we felt like just another "Bulldog", at home in BHS and proud of our achievements.

1958: Eagerly we re-entered the halls of BHS and watched the new freshmen stumble around. Charlie Nickerson, Woody French, and Judi Days were selected to lead us as class officers. Studies were harder and work more plentiful, so we settled down diligently to concentrate on academics. Not for long though, because we had a Soph — Frosh Frolic on the agenda! Jackie Ashton was elected queen and we conquered the cowering freshmen in her honor. Sadie Hawkins day arrived, and the boys had to watch their step as Judy Sullivan, our Daisy Mae, and her court, Dody Moses, Didi Bremer, and Ella Carter, led the girls in a race for dates to the "Dogpatch Hop". John Bateman was Lil' Abner, and Tom Bright, Buzz Rathgeber, and Bill Arnold escorted the girls in the court. Still another activity diverted us when we elected Linda Sikorski and Judi Days the Valentine Formal Court. With hardly a chance to catch our breaths, SA Campaigns overtook us; and to the tune of posters, speeches, skits, and excitement, Woody French became Vice President of the SA. The year ended, but we would never forget it.

1959: Now we had really begun to love our Alma Mater. A brother and sister team, Doug and Linda Sikorski, were chosen President and Secretary, while Archie Carroll was made Vice President. At long last we got our rings, mother of pearl set in gold, and this common band unified us as a class. Studies were harder than ever, but we managed to take time off now and then. Can we ever forget "Winter Fantasy", our Christmas Formal? Jackie Ashton was crowned queen in a surprise selection during the evening; and Ann Kalb, Betsy Dykes, Barbara Chieffalo, and Ella Carter, members of her court, were the first to applaud. In spite of our rings, we were still only "under" — upperclassman and had the responsibility of honoring the Seniors with a banquet and a Prom. The Jr. — Sr. Banquet was a huge success, featuring on the menu filet mignon. Doug Sikorski our Class President, presented the seniors with a magic potion, whipped up with parts of their lives in BHS and ready to serve. At the prom, Lucho put wings on everyone's feet and Ruthie Bennett and Jackie Ashton were members of the queen's court. This year, Sheila Wooten and Candy Southwell were our choices for the Valentine Formal court. Our Junior Class Beach Party was a gala event we'll always remember. Finally we finished the year in a whirl of SA campaigning, and Woody French was the victorious new SA Prexy. Now we would say good-bye to the Class of "60" and emerge as the Mighty SENIOR CLASS OF "61".

Recorded here in this 1961 Zonian, we view our Senior year. We recall ups and downs, cheers and tears, wins and losses. From that first day an eternity ago when we entered BHS, we have been working toward the day when we would receive our diplomas. We came in like lambs; we go out like lions. We attend the last Jamboree and the last Relays, we hear the last airplane roar over the school, we celebrate our last Carnival, we ascend the stage to accept our diplomas. These and other memories fill our hearts. All are part of our final year; none are despensible. Only a moment for tears — then the Class of "61" blasts off to shape the world!










