



# FOREWORD

Since Vasco Nunez de Balboa's discovery of the Pacific Ocean, during the 16th century, man has dreamed of constructing a canal connecting the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans.

In 1879, the French became the first to try to build a canal through Panama. However, they were unsuccessful because working as individual companies, without the backing of any government, they soon ran out of money and land their stockholders ran out of patience.

In the meantime, the United States became interested in the canal project. On November 18, 1903, the United States signed a treaty with the Republic of Panama leasing the Property known as the Canal Zone.

The construction was not easy, for they were faced with many difficulties which had to be overcome. Tons of mechanical equipment, as well as the effort of over one and a half million men were needed to complete the task of building the canal. In addition to this, the canal had to be built through rugged terrain, jungles, and swampland. The tropical sun and deadly diseases of Panama were detrimental to progress.

Nature presented other delays to work on the canal. Sanitation and land slides were the two major problems. There was brush to be cleared, swamps to be drained, and grass to be cut. Many buildings and areas had to be fumigated and solutions had to be found for what became an immense refuse disposal problem.












And so is it true of the individual, who comes in many shapes and sizes—each representing a race, a color, a creed.



# SOPHOMORES

Enclosed by the outline of the escutcheon, the first sketches are laid on the surface of the field. The design is incomplete; it blurs many times as it changes and evolves. When the artist's primary design is established, he sets to work indicating it in the initial lines. He sketches with a light pen the basic outline of his idea. Then he applies for the first time his sharp-edged blade to the surface. He does not carve deeply, as he is yet undecided upon his final pattern. In the same fashion, so does the sharp-edged blade of experience cut away the less durable material which conceals the individual's personality. The work seems too slowly accomplished and a sense of incompleteness often tends to hide the process. But the first engravings shape themselves into an evolving design as both the field and the individual stand forth against their backgrounds.

Caribbean Girls' State is a training program sponsored by the Canal Zone American Legion Auxiliary aimed at instructing the young women of today in the processes of city and state government. Based on the theory that the best way to learn something is by practicing it, Girls' State is held during the Easter vacation when those junior girls who have been selected by the advisors of the high schools attend a week long session at one of the military reservations in the Canal Zone.

Girls' State is staffed by American Legion Auxiliary members who volunteer their time and effort to this enter-

prise. Aiding them are junior counselors who are veteran Girls State citizens who served actively and demonstrated leadership qualities during the previous session.

The principle of "participation study" is activated through political campaigns and elections, a mock trial, and numerous senate sessions. The Girls' State program reaches its climax in the annual election of two representatives to Girls' Nation, a special continuation of the Girls' States sessions held in Washington, D. C., and dedicated to the National Government.
